Dynamic and highly regarded French pianist Fanny Azzuro has an active career as a recitalist and enthusiastic chamber music participant. A specialist in the music of Russian and French impressionist composers, she has performed in renowned venues all over France and abroad. Upcoming performances in the US include the French American Piano Society in New York City later this month as well as her Carnegie Hall debut as part of the New York Piano Festival in June. She has recorded six CDs of solo and chamber works and will record the Schumann Piano Concerto with the Czech National Symphony Orchestra in Prague in November. She will add three CDs to her discography in 2019, all featuring the works of Schumann.
