- Unaccompanied sonata, partita, or suite by Johann Sebastian Bach
- Sonata with piano from time of Mozart to present
- Concerto or major work for soloist with orchestra
- Short work or movement that shows virtuosity
- Work commissioned for this competition, to be sent to all semifinalists
